Key Person SEND Programme for EY practitioners

The Golden Key is an online training programme for practitioners in the role of the Key Person in Early Years PVI and maintained school settings. Perfect for those seeking to develop their knowledge, skills and confidence in working with children with SEND.



The programme will support practitioners to develop their knowledge, skills and confidence around:

- Legislation for SEND in the Early Years.
- High-quality interactions, observation techniques and assessment tools to identify children's learning and development needs.
- Supporting children with SEND through the Graduated Approach.
- Building relationships with children and their parents/carers, including handling sensitive conversations.
- Awareness of the role of the SENCO and outside agencies, and how to work together effectively to support children with SEND.





PROGRAMME DELIVERY:

This eight-week programme, funded by the Midlands Stronger Practice Hub, includes:

- Four 2-hour live online webinars, delivered fortnightly.
- Short gap tasks to be completed between sessions.
- Online drop-in support sessions on non-training weeks.
- Course participants will receive nasen's Certificate of Attendance.

The four live online training sessions will also be recorded to allow a more flexible approach to learning.
